

## General Thoughts:

- What is a Proposal?
- What type of funding are you seeking?
- Have you ever written a grant?
- Do you have the capacity to oversee?
- Have you planned your process?
- Once you receive funding, what are you requirements?
- Has your project changed?

#### The Brainstorming Process

- Criticism is ruled out
- Combination and improvement are sought
- Quantity and quality is wanted
- Don't pull rank
- Withold judgement on ideas that have been generated until later
- Encourage all ideas-the wilder the better
- Treat ALL group members as equals

## Refining Your Ideas

- 1. What is the idea for your project?
- 2. What is the problem?
- 3. Is the project feasible for you and your organization?
- 4. Do you have the expertise?
- 5. Whom will the project serve?
- 6. Who will direct the project and who will staff it?
- 7. Does the project have wider applicability?
- 8. What results should it achieve by the end of the project?
- 9. How long will the project take?
- 10. What geographic area will you serve?
- 11. How much will it cost to achieve the results you want?
- 12. Have you involved the community?

### Establish Goals & Objectives

- GOALS long-range outcome Not more than ten (10) per year
- OBJECTIVES short-range outcome Not more than three (3) objectives per goal

REMEMBER: Make it Measurable *"What gets measured gets done!"* 

#### Make Determinations

- Identify what goals are achievable in the determined timeframe.
- Determine what goals can be accomplished on a year to year basis to make progress in achieving the planning goals.
- After identifying goals, begin the project.
- If it is determined later, these goals cannot be accomplished in the time allotted, make the necessary revisions.

## Project Management

- What has changed since you applied for funding?
- Do you still have the capacity to meet the goals?
- Have the key players changed?
- Do you want the funding?
