- Founded in 2006 after Liz McCartney and Zack Rosenburg took a service trip to St. Bernard Parish, Louisiana
- This area was the most devastated by Hurricane Katrina with the least resources
- Ever since, SBP has gone to the areas with the greatest disaster recovery needs
- St. Bernard Project is currently rebuilding in:

New Orleans, LA following Hurricane Katrina

Rockaway, NY and Monmouth & Ocean Counties, NJ following Hurricane Sandy

San Marcos, TX following devastating flooding

Columbia, SC following historic flooding

Joplin, MO following the EF-5 tornado Recovery COMPLETED

- Local affiliate, "Friends of Rockaway" formed in response to the devastating effects of the storm on the Rockaway Peninsula
- Has rebuilt over 200 homes throughout the area since inception in late 2012
- The ONLY nonprofit working with New York City's Build it Back Program
- Will oversee New York State's "Project Uplift" home elevation pilot program

- Partnered with local group "Sea Bright Rising" in response to the devastating effects of the storm on the New Jersey Shoreline
- Has rebuilt 50 homes throughout the area since inception in early 2014
