


Introduction to ENERGY STAR for Residential New Construction





What's an ENERGY STAR Certified Home or Apartment?

- A home or apartment built to the ENERGY STAR guidelines and verified by a third party
- Delivers savings:
 - At least 10% more energy efficiency than homes built to code and achieve a 20% improvement on average
- Can provide improved quality, comfort, peace of mind, \$\$ savings, and durability to homeowners, residents, and property managers







ENERGY STAR & Affordable Housing

- ENERGY STAR certification is accessible by projects of all sizes, construction types, and price-points.
- Over 3,600 ENERGY STAR certified homes built within affordable housing sector using HUD financing in 2017.
- Over 16,500 ENERGY STAR Certified homes built by Habitat for Humanity & 120 active Habitat for Humanity affiliates nationwide.
