Women, Infants and Children (WIC): WIC is a supplemental food and nutrition education program for income eligible pregnant, postpartum, breast feeding women, and infants and children to 5 years of age. Income eligibility is based at or below 185% of the poverty level of the Federal Poverty guidelines. If you have Husky A Insurance you qualify for WIC. Participants receive nutrition education, counseling, and food package vouchers specifically tailored to meet their individual dietary needs and preferences. For women and children the vouchers are approximately \$60 per month. WIC supports breastfeeding as the best feeding choice for infants; for Infants who are receiving alternate feeding, formula checks are available. Participants should contact the WIC staff to determine program eligibility. State Foster children under 5 years are automatically eligible. Serves New London County.

Little Learners Early Education Program: Provides a licensed, quality, educational curriculum on a year round basis for children ages 6 weeks to 6 years. Little Learners Early Care Education centers are located in Taftville, New London, Groton, and Griswold. Little Learners fees are based on a sliding fee scale to help pay for the cost of care. All childcare subsidies are accepted. Our sites are NAEYC accredited and offer an educational curriculum to help children become school-ready.

Head Start (HS): Provides licensed quality child care to income eligible children birth to 5 yrs. Comprehensive services in the areas of nutrition. health, education, mental health, disabilities, parent involvement and family services. Two options are available in New London County: Center Based, and Early Head Start. Full-year and Part-year in NAEYC accredited facilities are available.

Individuals age 60 and older and their spouse are eligible to dine at Senior Community Café or eligible for home-delivered meals if homebound. Reservations are necessary. There are no income guide-lines. Referrals for home delivered meals are made by phone. 24 hour voice mail available.

Connecticut Energy Assistance Program / ESS:

The Connecticut Energy Assistance Program (CEAP) is a non-entitlement program that provides financial assistance to income eligible households towards their primary heating bills. Homeowners and renters may apply. Households eligible for Energy Assistance may also be eligible to receive Weatherization Assistance. Applications are taken at various locations throughout New London County.
