We've started to plan for this year's Energy Outreach Colorado (EOC) Annual Golf Classic - *The Heat is On* - that will take place at Sanctuary Golf Course on August 29th, 2018. This golf tournament is the only fund raising event hosted by EOC, and we are proud to have so many prominent sponsors support us each year. Last year we raised over \$151,000 for our statewide programs and we are hoping to reach much more this year. EOC has received top-ratings from Charity Navigator since 2003, and our average administrative costs are 5 percent. That means 95% of your donation will go directly toward assisting income-qualifying seniors, veterans, teachers, and many community members that have disproportionate home energy burdens.

The exclusive Sanctuary Golf Course is limited to those sponsoring a charity tournament, and *The Heat is On* provides you with the opportunity to share this unique experience with colleagues and friends. A faulty furnace is a crisis in winter months, especially when you can't afford a repair. 1,517 vulnerable households were in that situation and we were able to repair or replace their heating unit at no cost.

We CARE

Our CARE program provided energy efficiency upgrades to 290 vulnerable households. Improvements that will lead to lower bils and less energy consumption. And it's free to those who qualify.
