



Annual Funds, 2018-2022 (\$ millions)







Vulnerable Recipient Households


Households with Elderly Member




Households with Young Child

Types of Assistance

Heating Assistance served 133,635 households with reported average benefits of \$1,344 (regular LIHEAP funds) and \$1,344 (LIHEAP ARPA funds).

Weatherization Assistance served 8,932 households with a calculated average benefit of \$1,900.

*Total Funding Available includes \$4,857 returned to the federal government.
