

AI/Recording Policy:

The National Energy and Utility Affordability Coalition (NEUAC) board and committee meetings, planning sessions, and other meetings or trainings may be limited to specific audiences, or may include conversations that reflect development of policies or procedures. These conversations are proprietary and should not be recorded or shared except by NEUAC or with written permission from NEUAC (e.g. in the event such tools are necessary for handicap accessibility). For these reasons, in addition to concerns regarding privacy expectations and potential legal issues related to recording conversations without authorization, NEUAC prohibits the use of recordings or artificial intelligence tools designed to transcribe or summarize meetings or conversations during NEUAC-initiated virtual or in-person meetings, without regard as to whether such recordings are or are not stored on a cloud-based computer network or on a personal recording device.
