About NEUAC

The National Energy and Utility Affordability Coalition is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that bridges the gap between states, social service organizations, utilities, and government to empower them to work together and learn from each other to protect families in utility crises. NEUAC is dedicated to heightening the awareness of the energy needs of vulnerable households through advocacy and education. NEUAC also works to educate utility assistance professionals on effective practices for program implementation and collaboration to improve outcomes for those experiencing energy poverty.

In 2025, NEUAC achieved significant milestones, including hosting its annual conference with over 600 energy professionals, and an advocacy fly-in event with more than 250 attendees from 42 states, resulting in 264 meetings with Congress. Continued advocacy efforts protected LIHEAP in 2025, and an Open Letter to Congress in support of LIHEAP garnered 1,407 signatures nationwide. NEUAC also connected members across the country to share effective strategies for implementing utility programs, issued timely "Policy Update" email alerts, and organized successful efforts for LIHEAP Action Month, emphasizing the growing need for heating and cooling assistance.



LIHEAP Action Day

NEUAC's LIHEAP Action Day fly-in event connects advocates from across the country with policymakers on Capitol Hill to communicate the importance of LIHEAP. Our multi-day event provides advocacy training, policy discussion, networking, tools, talking points, and meeting scheduling.



Annual Conference

For more than 30 years, the NEUAC Annual Conference has brought together utility assistance professionals from nonprofit, government, tribal, and utility sectors to address critical issues such as crisis response, energy affordability, vulnerable populations, energy efficiency, renewables, water affordability, advocacy, policy, education, partnerships, and more.


