Nearly 6 million households across the U.S. received assistance from LIHEAP in FY2025.

Nearly 50,000 homes were weatherized using LIHEAP funds in FY2025, making them safer and more energy efficient.

In FY2025, LIHEAP **prevented disconnection or reconnected households** to energy or fuel more than 2 million times.
